- We are providing two 2-Bedroom furnished apartment located at:
 - Rosewood Apartments 26214 Redlands Blvd #9, & 26238 Redlands #71 and #111, Loma Linda, CA 92354. (Approximately 2 ½ miles from Loma Linda Hospital, located between Mountain View and California St.)
- Our focus is to help families with children receiving critical outpatient treatment for extended periods of time. If the family lives within 75 miles of the hospital, there must be a medical requirement that they remain a few minutes from the hospital during the recovery process.
- We will consider short-term stays (minimum of 7 days) or in-patient cases if apartment is available.
- Apartments have a phone with local calling available. Phone will not accept collect calls.
- If available, food, transportation, and calling cards may be provided to the family (based on need on a limited basis).
- The apartments are to be used by the family of a child with a serious or life-threatening illness/disease while they are receiving care at a local hospital. Occupancy is determined with the help of social workers based on the need of the family, type of illness and treatment, distance traveled, and determined by Board of Directors of Steven's Hope.
- Priority is given to needy families as follows:
 - Families of children receiving critical out-patient treatment for heart disease
 - Families of children receiving critical out-patient treatment for any disease or injury
 - Families of children receiving critical in-patient treatment for heart disease
 - Families of children receiving critical in-patient treatment for any disease or injury
- The length of stay and need will be re-evaluated on a weekly basis (as necessary) by a representative of Steven's Hope for Children with advice from the hospital physicians and social workers.
- \$150 Refundable Security Deposit & \$10 refundable key deposit required by family. (May be waived based on financial resources and social worker recommendation)
- \$10 per night to help cover expenses. (May be waived based on financial resources and social worker recommendation)
- Steven's Hope has lease agreement with Rosewood Apartments, therefore a sublease agreement is required.
- The maximum number of family members (including patient) allowed to stay in a apartment at any time is 5. All persons are to register their name with Steven's Hope.
- No minors under 18 can stay in apartment without a parent or legal guardian staying with them.
- All persons requesting to occupy the apartment should not have:
 - been asked to leave a housing facility (such as the Ronald McDonald House, Candlelighters facility, White House etc.) for breaking the rules, etc.
 - any prior felony convictions or convictions involving theft
 - any history of alcohol, drug or chemical dependency
 - any incidents of Child Abuse, a history of domestic violence or violent behavior
- Parent or legal guardian must maintain a permanent residence. Under no circumstances will occupancy be granted if the family does not have a home residence.
- Check In / Referral Procedures:
 1. Fax referral form to Steven's Hope for Children. (Can be obtained off Steven's Hope web site)
 2. Have family being considered complete and fax the Family Questionnaire to Steven's Hope for Children. (Can be obtained off Steven's Hope website)
 3. Once approved, a representative from Steven's Hope will meet with family at the hospital or at the apartment to complete check-in papers.
